GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING A STALLION BREEDING REPORT

FILE on-line at www.aqhamembers.com

- 1. The owner or lessee of every stallion (both American Quarter Horse and Thoroughbred to which American Quarter Horse mares have been exposed) must make a written report showing the names and registration numbers of all mares exposed to the stallion since the previous November. The report should include all mares owned and bred by the owner of the stallion as well as mares owned by other parties. It is not necessary to list mares whose foals will not be eligible for registration with AQHA, such as those registered with APHA, Arabian Horse Registry, grade mares, etc.
- 2. To aid you in filing this report, verify the exposed mare's registered name and number by looking at the Certificate of Registration to properly record it on this form.
- 3. Use a separate form for each stallion for each calendar year.
- 4. Handwritten signatures of the stallion owner (lessee) or authorized agent and their AQHA ID number are required for processing this report.
- 5. Thoroughbreds used for breeding American Quarter Horses must be recorded with AQHA. To record a Thoroughbred with AQHA, we must receive a photocopy of the front and back of The Jockey Club certificate showing current ownership, four pictures of the horse (one of each side, front and rear view) and a \$50 recording fee for members (\$90 for nonmembers). A Thoroughbred must be bred to a permanent registered American Quarter Horse for the offspring to be eligible for registration with AQHA. The offspring will be registered in the appendix registry.
- 6. An appendix registered horse must be bred to a permanent registered American Quarter Horse for the offspring to be eligible for registration with AQHA. The offspring will be registered in the appendix registry.

- The report must include all breeding dates and dates of exposure.
 a. Provide exact date(s) exposed if more than one service is given mare, indicate the different dates.
- If a mare is bred to produce more than one foal, she must be listed separately for each foal to be registered. For example, if three foals are to be registered, the mare must

be listed three separate times on the report.

If pasture exposed, provide date the mare was turned into the pasture and the date she was taken out of the pasture.

- 8. The filing fee is \$25 per stallion plus \$5 for each mare for members. If you are a nonmember, you may purchase a membership at the time you file this report for an additional \$40. Dues payments MAY BE deductible by members as ordinary and necessary business expenses; however contributions or gifts to the American Quarter Horse Association are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. However, donations to the American Quarter Horse Foundation ARE tax deductible to the extent allowed by law.
- 9. The deadline to file the report is November 30 of the breeding year (June 30 if south of equator). Reports postmarked after November 30th of the breeding year will include an additional \$30 late filing fee per late filing (not per mare as previously charged).
- 10. File your report online at aghamembers.com; or, mail the report to AQHA, Box 200, Amarillo, Texas 79168. Make sure it is postmarked by November 30 (June 30 if south of the equator).
