

Equine Research Committee Guidelines

1. Attend annual Committee meeting.
2. Review research project proposals which contain scientific information, including budgets, experimental design, animal use, statistical methods and previous research of applicants.
3. If assigned as primary person to review a project, do an in-depth study of the project and report to the Committee.
4. Approve and recommend research projects for grant funding.
5. Attend site visits as assigned.
6. Provide a written report of the site visit.
7. Review, if necessary, the site visit reports and determine if a project should be rejected or approved.
8. Monitor progress of approved projects.
9. Render unbiased decisions without regard to institutional or commercial affiliation or political agenda.
10. Review and recommend action on items that require scientific expertise.
11. Attend various scientific meetings as assigned by the chairperson.
12. Serve as scientific consultants to various AQHA standing committees.
