

## **Recreational Activities Committee Guidelines**

1. Develop and administer recreational programs and events which enhance and encourage American Quarter Horse ownership, participation, and enjoyment.
2. Develop and administer programs for AQHA members who enjoy caring for and/or training their horses, generally for recreational activities.
3. Oversee development and promotion of educational programs, activities and curricula that will benefit recreational owners.
4. Recommend adoption of or amendment to Association rules and fees pertaining to recreational programs.
5. Develop programs that encourage AQHA members to participate in trail advocacy activities.
6. Serve as the Public Policy committee's resource for trail legislation and regulation.
7. Develop coalitions with other recreational organizations.
8. Work to preserve open space for equestrian use.
9. Travel to appropriate venues to promote AQHA's recreational programs.
10. Be willing to serve on various task forces between annual meetings.
