Regional Experience Hardship Rules

For the Exhibitor:

An exhibitor may apply for a hardship in order to compete in a region of which they are not a resident. Application for hardship must be submitted to AQHA on or before the pre-entry deadline of the RE they wish to attend. The application must then be approved by the chairman of each region involved.

For the Horse:

A hardship may be applied for in order to show a horse in a region of which the owner is not a resident. Application for hardship must be submitted to AQHA on or before the pre-entry deadline of the RE they wish to attend. The application must then be approved by the chairman of each region involved.
