Specific Bequests

Percentage Bequests

“I give and bequeath _____% of my residual estate to the American Quarter Horse Foundation, 2601 East I-40, Amarillo, TX 79104, a State of Texas Corporation, to support its educational and charitable projects of interest and benefit to devotees of the American Quarter Horse.”

Restricted Bequests

“I give to the American Quarter Horse Foundation, 2601 East I-40, Amarillo, TX 79104, a State of Texas Corporation, the sum of (or property herein described), to be used for_____. At any time, however, in the event the original purpose of the gift no longer exists as determined by the board of directors, the board shall re-direct the proceeds of this gift to another purpose as determined by the board.”

Conditional Bequests

“If my wife does not survive me, I bequeath the sum of \$_____ to the American Quarter Horse Foundation, 2601 East I-40, Amarillo, TX 79104, a State of Texas Corporation, to support its educational and charitable projects of interest and benefit to devotees of the American Quarter Horse.”
