GO MAN GO HANDICAP

Los Alamitos, September 11, \$89,189, 400y, :19.291

1. Jess You And I (5G, Feature Mr Jess-Gold Daze by Tolltac. 21-12-3-3 \$1,320,786. O/B: Double Bar S Ranch LLC, T: Jaime Gomez, J: Alejandro Luna. Won February 21 Los Alamitos Winter Championship (GI) in last out.)

2. DH - A Mere Splash (5G, Splash Bac-A Mere Classic by A Classic Dash. 14-6-3-1 \$192,358. O: Felix Aguallo Gonzalez, B: Jose Luis Gonzalez, T: Carlos Gonzalez, J: Juan Andrade. Gelding was also second in Vessels Maturity (GI). A half brother to Grade I winner A Mere Chocolate.)

2. DH - Hawk In The City (4G, Hawkinson-City Image by Special Effort. 18-4-4-0 \$93,242. O: Jaime Gonzalez, B: EG High Desert Farms, T: Jose Flores, J: Guillermo Suarez. In his previous start, the stakes-winning gelding finished second in Spencer Childers California Breeders' Championship (RG1).)

JP Rhythm, Checker, Trisk, Separate Bet, Bannow Bay.

Jess You And I picked up where he left off in February, winning the Go Man Go Handicap (GI) by a half length as the 11-10 favorite. The champion gelding earned his fifth stakes win, and became the first horse in 40 years to win back-to-back editions of the race.

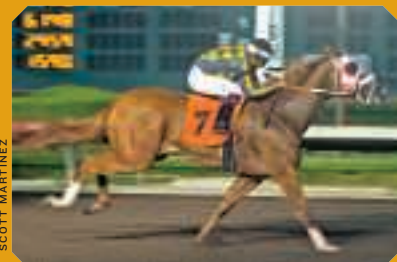

2. My Lady First (4M, First Down Dash-Lady Of Lake (TB) by Salt Lake (TB). 23-9-3-3 \$427,696. O: Rancho El Alacran Inc., B: Shultz Ranch, T: Adan Farias, J: Rodrigo Aceves. Mare is now four-times Grade I placed, won the California Breeders' Matron Stakes (RG2). Half sister My Sexy Lady (\$75,259), by Simply Silver Sage, is a GI finalist.)

3. Alice K White (3F, First Down Dash-Champagne Lane by Lanes Leinster. 11-5-2-1 \$276,837. O/B: MJ Farms, T: Mike Joiner, J: Cody Jensen. In her previous start, filly won the August 29 Golden State Derby (GI) over males, and earlier this year, she won the La Primera Del Ano Derby (G2). A half sister to Grade I winner Kendall Jackson.)

Forgive Him, Strength In Numbers, Look Her Over, Clydette Mia, Spanish Cartel, Answer The Dream. Scratched - Stylish Jess BR.

Sent off at 4-1, Terrific Energy dominated the Millie Vessels with a 1 1/4-length win, setting a stakes record and earning herself a berth to the Champion of Champions (GI). Last year's Millie Vessels winner, Stylish Jess BR, was scratched after being treated for symptoms of colic. In January, Terrific Energy won the Charger Bar Handicap (GI), and on August 21 was second to Stylish Jess BR in the Merial California Distaff Challenge (G3).

Dylans Dandy (5G, Streak And Dash-Freda Krystel by Seventy One North. 32-13-3-4 \$195,857, O: Preston and Karen Cloud, B: Preston Cloud, T: Guillermo Valdivia, J: Ricky Ramirez.),

Diamond Tres Seis, Adios My Amigos, Here To Entertain, Sailin Daylon, Ima Candy Suspect, Illegal Memories, Sassys Tuffy.

Streakin Cherry broke fourth and quickly made his way to the lead. The sorrel gelding beat favorite Noconi by a half length. This is the second stakes win for the gelding who won the All American Gold Cup (G3) in September.

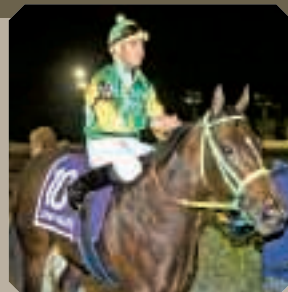

Jumpn Beduino is a full sister to Jumpn (SW, \$187,555), Jumpn Chick (SW, \$161,420), and a half sister to Jumpnout (SP, \$48,788) and Jumpnback (SP, \$73,158). Her stakes-winning dam, Imjumpn, is out of champion Jumping Tac Flash, who also produced champion Carters Cartel (\$659,146), Tac It Like A Man (SW, \$417,764), Flash First (SW, \$351,719) and A Tac First (SP, \$88,793).),

2. Headturner (2G, Check Him Out-Imjumpn by First Down Dash. 5-3-1-0 \$82,020, O: Jose Ramon Sandoval, B: Blane Schvaneveldt and J. Andreini, T: Jose Flores, J: Ramon Sanchez. This gelding is a half brother to winner Jumpn Beduino. He is a full brother to Jumpnout and Jumpnback.),

3. Princelike (2G, TR Dasher-Queen Mother by Raise A Secret. 4-3-0-1 \$60,920, O/B: Edward Allred, T: Jose Flores, J: Dennis Means.),

Cash For Cottontail, Brazilian Dasher, Miss Eye Stocks, Effectiveimmediately, Its All About FDD, Cloned With Class. Scratched - Hawk Mas Dinero.

Jumpn Beduino broke second and bore out badly, but the brown filly managed to beat Headturner by a neck. This is the first stakes win for the Chicks Beduino filly. Favorite Effectiveimmediately was fractious in the gate and bumped at the start.

ROBERT L. BONIFACE LOS ALAMITOS INVITATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

1. Freaky (4G, TR Dasher-Chickasecret by Raise A Secret. 22-8-0-6 \$271,300. O: Armando Aguirre, B: Edward Allred, T: Adan Farias, J: Francisco Rubio. Dam is a half sister to Hard Hitting (by TR Dasher, \$358,923) and Lassen County (by Pritzi Dash, \$146,229).),

2. A Mere Splash (5G, Splash Bac-A Mere Classic by A Classic Dash. 15-6-4-1 \$217,858. O: Felix Aguillo Gonzalez, B: Jose Luis Gonzalez, T: Carlos Gonzalez, J: Juan Andrade. Now second three times in a Grade I.),

3. Hawk In The City (4G, Hawkinson-City Image by Special Effort. 19-4-4-1 \$107,242. O: Jose Antonio Flores, B: EG High Desert Farms, T: Jose Flores, J: Guillermo Suarez. The gelding deadheat-ed for second with A Mere Splash in the Go Man Go, and also ran second to Freaky in the Spencer Childers California Breeders' Handicap (RG1).),

My Lady First, JP Rhythm, Go Straight, Jess You And I, Fighter On Fire, Time For A Royal Dip, Head Bud.

Freaky stamped out another resounding argument in his 2009 campaign for world champion, defeating a field of older horses that included champion Jess You And I by 1 1/4 lengths in a stakes-record time. He was also only 2/100ths off the track record set by Jess You And I in December. The blaze-faced gelding got out of the gate cleanly and went right to the lead, drawing away much the best. He earned a 106 speed index, and added this race to a tally which includes the Vessels Maturity (G1) and Spencer Childers California Breeders' Championship (RG1).
