



# It's All Fun & Games

## World Show exhibitors and spectators will have many chances to win fabulous prizes.

At this year's AQHA World Championship Show it will be fun and games for both exhibitors and spectators.

Each day, prizes will be given away in a variety of exciting ways.

### HAVE SOME FUN

● **Farnam Fun Face** – Five times each day, the arena's videographer will put a person up on the big screen. Whenever you hear the announcer say, "Ladies and Gentlemen, it's time to get on your feet and be noticed for the Farnam Fun Face!" make sure you're seen. The winner will then have to make their way to the Q-Zone for a free prize from AQHA Corporate Partner Farnam.

● **Farnam Exhibitor Spotlight** – Four times each day, the arena announcer will highlight particular World Show exhibitors. The spotlighted exhibitor will then need to go to the Q-ZONE for a free prize from Farnam.

● **John Deere Rake Break** – Occasionally when the the Kiser crew is in the arena with their John Deere tractors, they will be throwing John Deere items to the crowd.

● **John Deere Spotlight** – Other times when the tractor is in the arena, the announcer tell the crowd that the first person to come to the Q-ZONE wearing a John Deere item will get a prize.

● **Journal Sit and Win** – Occasionally, a specific section, row, seat will be announced. If you're in that seat, come to the Q-ZONE for a prize.



**GOLDEN CHANCE:** At the end of each finals, the champion will toss four unique T-shirts to the crowd.

● **Outfitters Hour** – Every day around 5 p.m., AQHYA mascot Two Bits will throw red AQHA shirts to the crowd.

● **Ford Fiesta Buckets** – During the Team Wrangler Showdown November 14-17, the section that cheers the loudest will get 10 buckets of food. The winner will be determined by Two Bits.

● **Golden T-Shirt Toss** – The champion of each finals event will toss four golden T-shirts to the crowd. Each T-shirt will feature a unique saying that ties into that finals event. Check each finals day in *Journal at the World* to see what sayings will be on the T-shirts.

### PLAY SOME GAMES

Starting on November 6, the Justin Challenge-Arena Games begin.

Here's when the games are scheduled with descriptions of each game below:

- Between Team Penning and Ranch Sorting (November 6) - Pony Express
- After Reining (November 7) – Boot Race
- After Cutting (November 8) – Pony Express
- After Team Wrangler Showdown (November 14) – Dizzy Tail Race
- After Team Wrangler Showdown (November 15) – Three-Hoof Nutrena Race
- After Team Wrangler Showdown (November 16) – Boot Race
- After Senior Reining (November 17) – Dizzy Tail Race

**Pony Express:** Ten people from the stands will be randomly chosen to play Pony Express. This is a match race with four cones. The first team to successfully get their mail from person one to person five and back wins.

**Dizzy Tail Race:** Five competitors chosen randomly from the stands will each be given a bat. Each contestant will then place their forehead on the end of bat and spin. They will then be told to stop and run to a point in the arena where there is a cone. The first person to make it back wins.

**Where are my Boots?** Contestants randomly chosen will be asked to remove their shoes. The shoes will then be placed in a pile in the arena. The first person to find the shoes in the pile and return to the starting line wins.

**Three-Hoof Nutrena Race:** One person puts their left leg in a Nutrena Feed sack and their partner places their right leg. The first team to a pylon and back to the starting line wins.
