

## **Exhibitor Fact Sheet**

- Exhibitor/Rider must be a current AQHA member and hold appropriate membership for USDF/USEF. For USDF & USEF membership requirements please contact USDF 859-971-2277 and USEF 859-258-2475.
- To compete, the horse must have an AQHA Dressage Competition License (onetime fee of \$85) and for USDF/USEF requirements please contact USDF 859-971-2277 and USEF 859-258-2475.
- Open, amateur and youth eligibility are based on AQHA criteria.
- Dressage competition must be USDF-recognized and USEF-licensed. To earn AQHA points, it must also be AQHA-approved.
- AQHA points can be earned starting at Training Level going through Grand Prix.
  Points cannot be earned in Dressage prior to licensing through AQHA. The points
  are listed on the horse's record and count for awards such as Register of Merit,
  year-end high points and also count for Incentive Fund payout. Incentive Fund
  payout is not eligible for Training level.
- AQHA recognizes high points (first through 10th) for open, amateur and youth divisions for each level.
