INCENTIVE FUND ANNUAL LICENSE

In addition to the nomination requirements, a foal must also be licensed each year in the division(s) (Open and/or Amateur) to earn Incentive Fund money (Incentive Fund License). For example if an Amateur Incentive Fund License is purchased for a foal but not an Open Incentive Fund License, the foal is eligible to earn Incentive Fund money for Amateur points it earns after the purchase date of the Amateur Incentive Fund License, but not for Open points.

The fee for an Open Incentive Fund License is \$50 and the fee for an Amateur Incentive Fund License is \$50.

If the record owner of the foal is both the nominator of the sire for the breeding season in which the foal was conceived AND the nominator of the foal, AQHA will waive Incentive Fund License Fees described in above for the first year the foal is shown.

For purposes of this program, an Incentive Fund License is considered "purchased" once AQHA has received a properly completed Incentive Fund License application and has processed the application and associated fee. License fees can be paid at a show if the owner has not sent the license fee to AQHA directly. The owner of the horse would be eligible to earn Incentive Fund money from that show date forward.

An Incentive Fund License may be purchased at any time. However, no Incentive Fund money will be paid to the foal owner prior to the Incentive Fund License being purchased.

An Incentive Fund License that is purchased on or before January 31st is effective for the entire show year (January 1 – December 31).

An Incentive Fund License purchased after January 31st is effective from the purchase date assigned by AQHA through December 31st of the show year.

Once purchased, an Incentive Fund License remains effective for a foal regardless if the foal changes ownership.

All Incentive Fund Licenses expire at the conclusion of the show year (December 31st), and a new Incentive Fund License(s) must be purchased in accordance with the above program rules in order for the foal to be eligible to earn Incentive Fund money in the following show year.

If a foal is nominated to the Incentive Fund, but is not licensed in accordance with the program, the nominator of the sire for the breeding season in which the foal was conceived and the nominator of the foal shall remain eligible to earn Incentive Fund Money for the points earned by the foal.

Incentive Fund will not be paid on points earned at introductory shows
Incentive Fund will not be paid on points earned in rookie or Level 1 (Novice/Green) classes
Incentive Fund will not be paid on points earned in Dressage training level
