

2022 Youth Art Show

Rules and Guidelines

Please read the rules and guidelines for the 2022 Youth Art Show to ensure your entry is accepted.



1. All participants must register online at www.aqha.com/yas by **November 1, 2022**. If registration is not received, student's artwork will not be judged for the exhibit. All entries will receive a confirmation email from the museum stating the proper forms were received.
2. We are interested in work that captures the spirit of the American Quarter Horse and celebrates the artist's unique love of horses.
3. All Submissions must be dropped off at the American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame & Museum by Tuesday, November 15.
4. Eligible entries will be juried by a committee and winners will be announced at our reception on December 8.
5. Artwork must be **no larger than 15" x 19"** and securely mounted on no larger than a 16" x 20" piece of flat black foam core with a **minimum of a one inch border** around the artwork. (The one-inch border allows our staff to hang the art for display without damaging the piece.)
6. Contestants are limited to one entry each. Entries may be in a medium of the artist's choice but must be a medium presentable on good quality bond or drawing paper, or illustration board.
7. In addition to artwork, students must submit their 100 word essay explaining what inspired their art piece.
8. Three dimensional pieces will be accepted on a limited basis.
9. Entries using photography, or graphic design as their primary medium will not be considered for this contest.
10. Entries are not to be framed.
11. Composition must be original.
12. Up to 100 selected pieces will hang in the American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame & Museum to be viewed by the public.
13. Students eligible for entry must be 11-18 years old.

AQHF and AQHA understand and agree that the actual physical Artwork itself is and shall remain the sole property of the Undersigned.

The Undersigned hereby waive any right that they may have to inspect or approve AQHF’s or AQHA’s use of the Images. Undersigned agree that any proceeds derived from the sale, publication or use of the Images is the sole property of AQHF. AQHF and AQHA agree that such proceeds shall be used exclusively for the advancement of the American Quarter Horse Foundation and its participants.

The Undersigned hereby release, discharge, and agree to hold harmless AQHF and AQHA from any liability by virtue of any blurring, distortion, alteration, optical illusion, or use in composite form, whether intentional or otherwise, that may occur in AQHF’s or AQHA’s use of the Images.

The Undersigned hereby warrant that they have the authority to grant the above license and that they have read and understand the above terms. If signing below as a legal guardian, such person warrants that he/she is fully authorized to do so. This release shall be binding on the Undersigned and their heirs, legal representatives, successors, and assigns.
