Fashion Show Rules

1. All contestants must be AQHYA members in good standing.
 - a. Two youths (one to model jeans, one to model boots) may be selected by each affiliate.
 - b. Boys and girls may participate in the fashion show.

Fashion Show Process

1. Contestants will wear clothing by AQHYA sponsors. Wranglers Jeans and Justin Boots decorated for the AQHYA Wrangler Jeans and Justin Boots Decorating Contest.
2. Contestants will be introduced by AQHYA Officers.
 - a. Brief contestant bios are due to the Youth World Show youth office by Sunday, August 6, at noon.
 - b. Go order for fashion show will be drawn prior to the show.
3. Representatives of the sponsors or other selected individuals will be asked to participate as judges.
 - a. Contestants will be judged on the following categories:
 - i. Representation of AQHYA Theme, "Reach Out".
 - ii. Artistic Creativity Representation of State/Provincial/ International Affiliate.
 - iii. Originality
 - iv. Fashion Show Presentation
 - b. Contestants are allowed to walk the runway with their silent auction basket and then join the crowd. Contestants will be judged as they socialize.
4. The fashion show counts toward the Team Spirit Award.

Silent Auction Fundraiser

AQHYA Officers have established a tradition of supporting the Rein in Cancer by encouraging Youth World Show contestants to participate in a fashion show exhibiting decorated Wrangler Jeans and Justin Boots. This event is intended as a fun way to promote the importance of community service among AQHYA members.

1. Each fashion show contestant is encouraged to create a gift basket for inclusion in the silent auction.
 - a. Participating contestants will attach silent auction bid sheets to their displayed gift baskets in order to take bids at their stalls prior to the fashion show.

- b. Contestants will then bring the bid sheets and gift baskets to the fashion show and pin exchange for additional bidding.
 - c. Upon conclusion of the evening's activities, the bidding will close.
 2. Charity
 - a. Rein in Cancer will be the charity.

Pin Exchange Process

Each state will bring a unique pin to be traded and collected by the youth and adults at the social event. AQHYA lanyards, provided by AQHYA, will be used to display the pin collections.
