



AQHA Open-Division Roping Pilot Qualifying Points for 2021

American Quarter Horses can qualify for the open-division roping classes by meeting one of the three following requirements:

- 1.) Earn the required number of qualifying points for the desired class during the 2021 Farnam AQHA World qualifying period, August 1, 2020, to July 31, 2021, and pay the standard Farnam AQHA World entry fee.

Level 2 Junior Heading	6.5
Level 2 Junior Heeling	8
Level 3 Junior Heading	13
Level 3 Junior Heeling	16
Level 2 Senior Heading	10
Level 2 Senior Heeling	10.5
Level 3 Senior Heading	20
Level 3 Senior Heeling	21
Level 2 Junior Tie-Down	2.5
Level 3 Junior Tie-Down	5.5
Level 2 Senior Tie-Down	5.5
Level 3 Senior Tie-Down	11

- 2.) Participate in three AQHA-approved events during the 2021 Farnam AQHA World qualifying period and pay the standard Farnam AQHA World entry fee, regardless of number of points earned. Participation credit is earned by horse on a class-by-class basis. AQHA events encompass all judge numbers for a particular show or circuit. For example, the Arizona Sun Circuit is considered one event, even though it includes eight sets of points.
- 3.) If the American Quarter Horse does not earn the required amount of qualifying points or does not attend three AQHA-approved events by class during the 2021 Farnam AQHA World qualifying period, the American Quarter Horse can still be entered in the Farnam AQHA World for a significantly higher entry fee per class entered.
