Mr. President, the public policy committee makes the following recommendations:

1. For AQHA to support our agriculture partners who oppose state and local initiatives which are detrimental to the equine and livestock industry.
2. To approve the AQHA Legislative and Regulatory Policy Book as submitted by task force.
3. To approve the procedures to modify AQHA's Legislative and Regulatory Policy Book.
4. To appoint a public policy subcommittee to evaluate member and affiliate policy recommendations prior to being submitted to the public policy committee for review.
5. To establish a task force to develop policy to be included in AQHA's Legislative and Regulatory Policy Book on issues related to equine health and well-being.
6. To establish a task force to create and conduct year-round fundraising for AQHA's Political Action Committee.
7. For AQHA to develop a letter writing campaign regarding the Food and Drug Administration's request for comments on the Use of Antimicrobials in Companion Animals.
8. To elect James Clement as the public policy committee chair.
