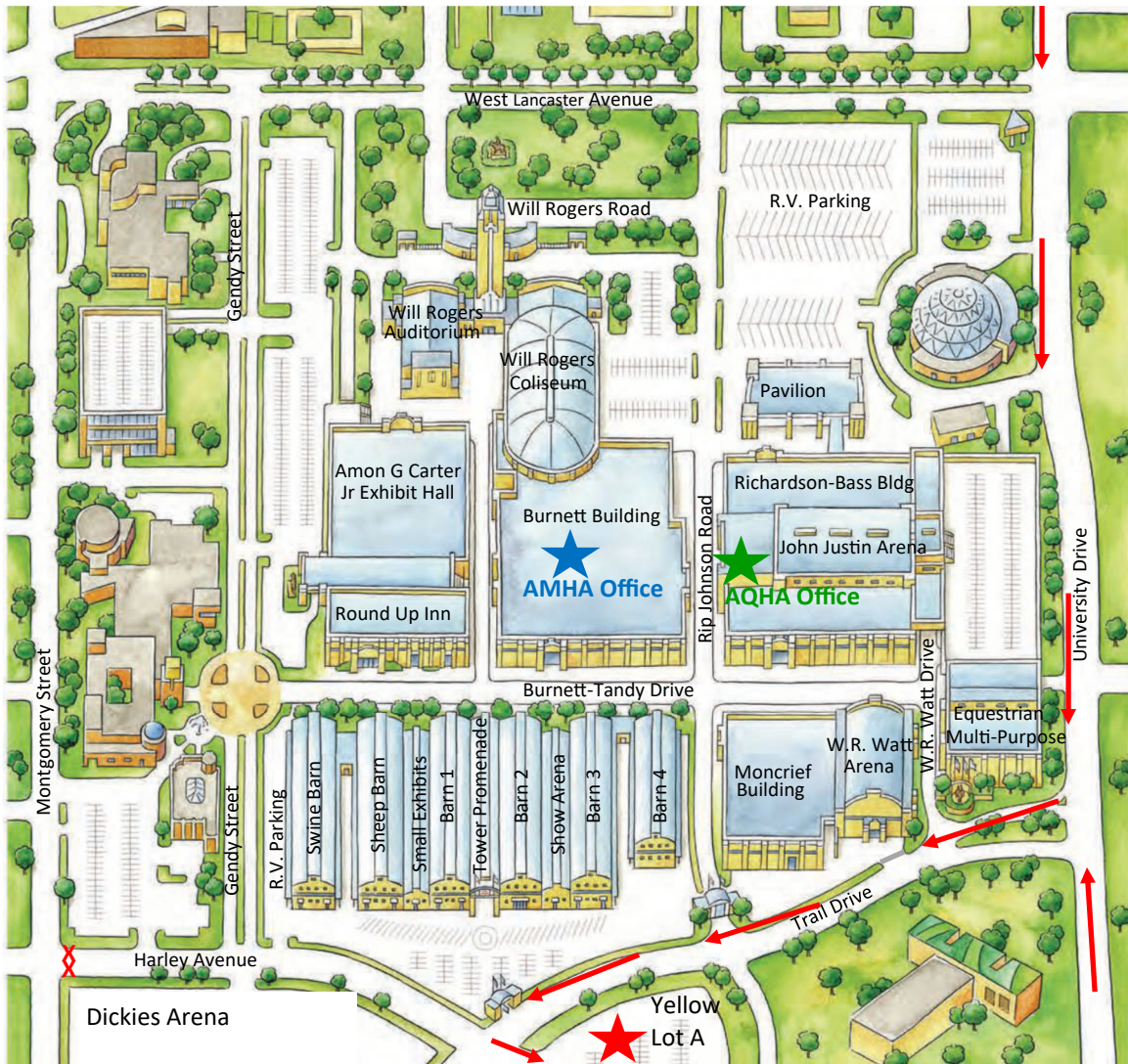




## Horse Arrival instructions



### Directions from I-30 via University Drive to:

**Equestrian Inspection Station (★):** At the 1st red light, turn west (left) on Trail Drive. At intersection with Harley Avenue, turn east (left) into Yellow Lot A (Gate 43). Staff will be checking health papers as noted below and doing a visual inspection of all horses arriving prior to directing you onto the show grounds.

### Entry Requirements for all horses as regulated by the Texas Animal Health Commission:

#### Intrastate (Equine moved within the state of Texas)

- A negative EIA test is required within the previous 12 months prior to entering.

#### Interstate (Equine moved into the state from other states)

- A negative EIA test is required within the previous 12 months prior to entering.
- Certificate of veterinary inspection within 30 days prior to entry.

**\* All horses coming from a state that has current Vesicular Stomatitis cases, MUST have a Health Certificate dated within 14 days of arrival. Affected states include, but are not limited to: Texas, New Mexico, Colorado, Wyoming and Oklahoma.**

\* The Inspection Station has been implemented by the recommendation of the Texas Animal Health Commission as a precautionary and safety measure with the recent outbreak of Vesicular Stomatitis in Texas and neighboring states.
