

GORDON CRONE SPECIAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The Gordon Crone Special Achievement Award is given yearly to an outstanding man within the American Quarter Horse racing industry to recognize his achievement within the industry **throughout the current year, January 1 – Present, 2017**. The award is voted on by the AQHA Racing Committee. The first award was presented in 1994.

A longtime horseman from Kansas and an AQHA director from 1985 – 1992, Gordon Crone worked to promote American Quarter Horse racing both in his state and nationally. Gordon and his wife, Juanita, raced the champion gelding Vespero in the late 1970s and early 1980s. Vespero, a son of the Three Bars (TB) stallion St Bar, was named the 2-year-old champion gelding in 1978. When Vespero and Crone won the Rainbow Futurity, trainer Marilyn Asmussen became the first female trainer to saddle a major stakes winner. Crone passed away on February 12, 1994 at the age of 74.
