



2018 Mutton Bustin'

The 2018 Lucas Oil AQHA World Championship Show Mutton Bustin' is scheduled for 6 p.m. on November 3, 2018, in the Jim Norick Arena at State Fair Park in Oklahoma City.

Contestants will be selected to participate in the AQHA Mutton Bustin'. Entries will be accepted until **November 1**. For this contest, we will hold two rounds. Contestants will be assigned to compete in one round; then the top contestant from each round will compete head-to-head in the championship round.

General Rules: Mutton Bustin' contestants must be between the ages of 4 and 7 and weigh less than 55 pounds, including clothes and boots. During the ride, contestants may use one or two hands, with officials having the option to reward one-handed rides. Child must ride for six (6) seconds to score and receive points. Sheep shall be chute-run. **Helmets and vests are required and will be provided.**

Additional Information:

- **ONLY SELECTED APPLICANTS WILL BE NOTIFIED**
- Only one entry per child will be accepted.
- Each child may compete only once in AQHA's Mutton Bustin' competition.
- Contestants are required to dress in long-sleeve collared shirts, jeans and boots.
- Each contestant will receive two free admission tickets to the Match Roping, one ticket for the contestant and an additional ticket for their guardian to attend the event on November 3.
- Each participant will receive a specially designed medallion, and the winner will receive a certificate for an AQHA Mutton Bustin' Champion belt buckle.
